- Legislature Jeri Meeks, Tara Fuchs-Roesler, Pat Schneider Jeri sent in a report which is attached. She particularly discussed two bills: HR 2454 and SB 1500. HR 2454 puts Telehealth standards in place for health provider/patient communication. SB1500 moves the Elderly Assistance Fund from Maricopa County to the State. Jeri also reported that 68% of the nursing homes have Covid cases. There is another bill that adds restrictions to HealthCare Directives that require regular communication between the primary person and the person responsible for carrying out the directive. Pat discussed two election-related bills. One requires that all early ballots be received by the Thursday prior to the Tuesday election. The other requires that applications for mail-in ballots must include birthdate and proof of address.

ASURA Government Liaison Group Report

The Government Liaison Group - Pat Schneider, Larry Carlson, Tara Roesler, Martha Cocchiarella, Jeri Meeks, Joanie Baker (NAURA) - has been meeting weekly on Tuesdays to discuss legislature-related articles and active bills moving through this legislative session. Here are our notes as of March 2, 2021.

HB2138: ABOR optional retirement programs did not cross over to the Senate and is still stagnant. Also, I didn't see this language inserted into a strike everything bill.

Per a March 2nd Capital Times Morning Scoop Zoom meeting, discussing Covid-19 in nursing homes and senior living facilities (from Dec 21, 2020-Jan17 2021), 67.8% of these facilities reported Covid-19 cases and 144 deaths. Although a little better than last reporting period, that's still very high. Appropriation bill SB1500 is asking for approximately \$5M for facility inspectors, watchdogs and an audit. *Ask the Board if we can support this bill".

Pat Schneider reported that there was a lot of movement regarding election bills - including bills moving between congressional branches after the official crossover date. She also reported that 925 bill died in committee(s).

All of the active strike everything bills that we were watching have been re-allocated to topics we are not following.

I haven't seen any discussion regarding ABOR's appropriation request.

SB1051 - ASRS; employer payments; ineligible contributions

SB1500 - NOW: elderly assistance fund; state treasure

SB1054 – ASRS; self-insurance program

HB2008- ASRS; employer; member; contributions

SB1053 - ASRS; non participatory employer liability

Election related bills

HRC2020 – Establish the position of Lieutenant Governor

HB2529 – Required instructions on early ballots

HB2792 – Early ballots can only be sent to someone who requests it
