Robert (Bob) Hershberger earned his PhD in architecture at the University of Pennsylvania. He served in the Army National Guard and is a member of the Payson United Methodist Church, AIA Arizona and the Rio Salado Architecture Foundation. He is past president of the Payson Art League, a board member of the Friends of Tonto Natural Bridge and is an active artist, author, and urban design consultant living in Payson, Arizona.

Bob taught architecture at Idaho State University, and Drexel University. He served as a professor of architecture at Arizona State University (ASU) for 18 years from University of Arizona (UA) for 14 years where he also served as Dean of the College of Architecture.

Bob was married for nearly 55 years to Deanna Hershberger (Dee) who passed away from complications related to Alzheimer's disease in 2015. He was Dee's primary caregiver and recorded his daily experiences in a journal which he has since had published as a book.
